PARISH EVENTS

Bake Sale

Each Memorial Day and Labor Day weekend, our ladies group (CCW) asks our parish bakers to make a treat for sale after Mass. The proceeds go to the CCW, who support needed items inside the church.

Cana Dinner

Each February, around Valentine's Day, we offer a special blessing and dinner to any parish married couples. It is a fun time, and we need some people to organize and set up the festivities. We end with a dinner at a local restaurant!

Fashion Show

Once a year, in the fall, our CCW group puts on a fantastic fashion show. Our own parish members are the models. We need people to contribute and serve food or to model.

Fellowship Treats

Almost each month, we offer a doughnut or treat Sunday (and when we have the Saturday Mass, then on a Saturday). This is a simple offering of sweets and beverages after the Mass to encourage parish fellowship. If you can help, we need people to start the coffee, set out the treats and help clean up.

Funeral Dinners

At the request of a family who has lost a loved one, our CCW puts on a funeral dinner for that family. We need people to donate food items, serve the food and clean up. It is truly a ministry of the heart!

Golf Classic

Towards the end of June, our Men's Club has sponsored a parish golf outing at Golden Sands Golf Club. We need helpers to gather prizes for the golfers, raise foursomes and help set up the dinner. Proceeds go to the Men's Club, who support our buildings & grounds.

New Member Dinner

Once a year, we put on a free dinner for a mixture of new and veteran parishioners. We have the food brought in for this, but we also discuss our backgrounds and greet the new members. If you would like to attend, please let us know.

Parish Fall Retreat

In September, Deacon Mike or a guest director offers a half day parish retreat. If you would like to be a part of helping put this together, please check with Deacon Mike.

Parish Picnic

Our annual parish picnic, in August, is free to all members. All parish members and guests are welcome, but we do need help with a dish to pass, or help with set up or clean up. This is a fun and delicious event, as we simply have a social time, win some door prizes and eat.

Plant Sale

Every year, in the spring, we have a flower/plant sale. We need helpers to organize this, get the plants and flowers in at delivery, and then publicize this parish fund raiser.

Rummage Sale/Brat Fry

Each Memorial Day weekend, our Men's Club has had a rummage sale and brat fry—it's hard to tell which of the two attracts more people! We need helpers to gather items, put them out on sale day, take in the funds, and cook the brats.
